

MOVE-OUT CHECKLIST FOR TENANTS

Moving Out

- Set up an inspection appointment by calling your housing authority at least five days before you move out.
- Your housing authority will compare your unit's condition on the day you move out to the unit's condition on the day you moved in as noted on your copy of the Rental Unit Condition Report (Move-in).
- Under the *Residential Tenancies Regulations, 2006*, Section 8(1), you must keep your unit reasonably clean and fix anything that you damage in the unit. You are not responsible for reasonable wear and tear. Your housing authority will inform you of any charges for cleaning and damage beyond normal wear and tear.

Reminders

(if applicable)

- Moving vehicles are not allowed on lawns or sidewalks.
- Arrange for Canada Post mail forwarding services before move-out.
- Schedule disconnection of utility services (power, heating, and/or water) for the day you move out.

Cleaning Checklist	
Cupboards/Doors	Clean and wash inside and outside including top and bottom exterior
Counters	Clean and wash; remove dirt and spots
Kitchen Sink/Taps	Clean and wash; remove water spots and polish
Stove/Hood	Pull out; clean back and sides Remove and clean stove top, burner rings, drip pans, and under drip pans Clean and wash oven, including broiler pan, racks, and lower drawer Clean and wash wall and floor behind and under stove
Refrigerator (keep plugged in and closed)	Pull out; clean back, sides, and top Defrost, wash, and clean interior (including door seal) Clean and wash wall and floor behind and under refrigerator
Bathroom Sink/Taps	Clean, wash, and polish
Toilet	Clean and wash inside and outside
Tub/Showerhead/Taps	Clean and wash inside and outside; polish fixtures
Vanity/Medicine Cabinet	Clean and wash inside and outside, including mirror
Bathroom Fan Cover	Clean and wash
Washer and Dryer (if applicable)	Pull out, clean back, sides, and top Clean and wash interior and exterior Clean and wash walls and floor behind and under washer/dryer
Windows/Screens	Clean glass inside, outside, screens, and between window panes (if possible) Clean and wash tracks, frames, and sills
Walls (filling picture nail holes not required)	Wash all walls including doors, closets, closet doors, frames, and shelving Clean all heat registers, baseboards, outlet covers, etc.
Light Fixtures	Clean and wash all fixtures Replace burnt-out bulbs
Carpets	Vacuum and spot clean or shampoo as necessary
Floors (e.g. laminate, linoleum)	Sweep and wash all floors
Basement (if applicable)	Remove personal items and trash; sweep and wash floor, as necessary
Furnace/Water Heater	Replace or clean filter
Patio/Deck/Balcony	Sweep
Yard	Remove and dispose of trash as required by municipal bylaw Rake leaves Cut grass and remove weeds Remove snow from sidewalks
Shed	Remove personal items and trash; sweep floor; leave door closed and unlocked
