2019 SPRING CLEAN UP WEEK

will be **MAY 27th to MAY 31.**

The City will be picking up your debris in the back alley this week, the pickup time is at 8:00 am. You must have it all bagged (leaves, grass, garden refuse ONLY) - branches must be broken up into short lengths for easy pickup.

If you have any garbage (Couches, beds, other furniture, small appliances etc.) that the town will not pick up; the Meadow Lake Housing Authority will pick up on the **EAST side MONDAY and TUESDAY ONLY & WEST Side WEDNESDAY and THURSDAY ONLY.**

Bring these items to the curb for pick up;
staff will not enter the premises!!

Spring is Just Around the Corner

The Meadow Lake Housing Authority would like to take this time to remind you that as the season is changing it is your responsibility to properly maintain your home. The warm weather is the perfect time to wash screens, windows and doors, pick up garbage, rake the yard, and spring clean in the home.

****THE CONDITION OF THE YARD OUTSIDE REFLECTS ON THE PERSON LIVING INSIDE****

As per your Lease Agreement
(Schedule "A", Section 8(2) "A tenant must maintain reasonable health, cleanliness and sanitary standards throughout the rental unit and must repair damage to the rental unit..."

Just a reminder notice that we might have a lot of water around our homes this spring.

To help reduce the risk of wet basements we are asking tenants to:

- Remove snow from around your foundations (and around basement windows)
- Clear snow and ice and ice from around the bottom of your downspouts, at least two meters so water drains away from your foundation.
- Once snow melts, make sure water is draining away from your house, by making small ditches to divert water away from house
- Make sure items are off the floor, just in case some moisture does get in on basement floors.

Please do not park on the lawn or drive over the curbs and sidewalks, this causes damage and a charge of \$200.00 will be added to your account.

TIPS ON YARD CARE

- ***Rake all grass areas with a fan rake to remove dead grass, leaves, debris***
- ***Watering During drought periods the only way to maintain a green lawn is to give it a thorough soaking once or twice a week. Light daily sprinklings do more harm than good.***
- ***Grass Cutting - mow grass at regular intervals which keeps grass height from exceeding 4 inches. Heavy grass clippings should be removed after mowing and trimming to prevent suffocation of grass below.***
- ***Lawns must not reach more than 4 inches in length or you will be charged \$100.00 to have the Housing Authority come to mow your lawn; third offense will be double, \$200.00! Failure to maintain your unit and yard may result in an Eviction for Breach of your Lease Agreement.***
